Music Theory Grade 1 Lesson 1 Notes



Music can be thought of as two simple elements, sounds that are played and playing these sounds at certain times. When a musical instrument makes a single sound, the sound is called a note. This note has a pitch (how high or low the sound is) and a duration (low long it sounds for . Every instrument is designed to make these notes in various ways. You may hit something, blow through something, push something or even sweeze something to make the instrument produce the note. Notes make up music to form melodies, harmonies and rhythms. In written music, notes are represented by circles (or ovals) placed on or between lines. The position of the circle will respresent a change in the sound of the note produced.
